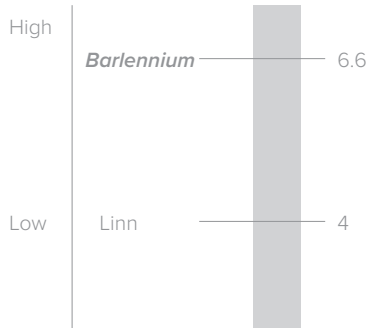

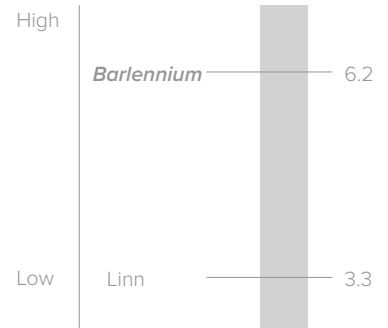

Barlennium provides the greatest benefits when mowed at taller heights, around 2-3".

Leaf Texture



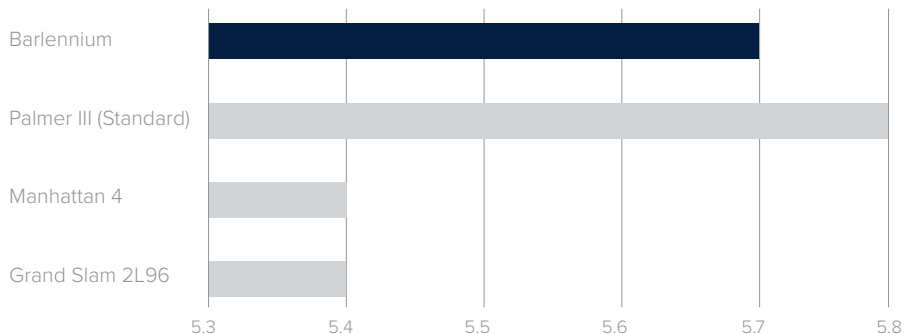
1999 NTEP, LSD=.3
