KENTUCKY BLUEGRASS



Elites

After Midnight[™] (Virginia/Maryland Recommended Turfgrass list) I

- Slow growing, compact Midnight-type with excellent uniformity and wear tolerance
- Improved shade tolerance, darker color, and Dollar Spot tolerance

Award™

- Top rated in spring density and ground cover, late fall color, and traffic and wear tolerance
- Exceptional heat tolerance

Barserati™

- Top performing in NTEP transition zone, turf quality, color, traffic, and disease resistance
- Quick to germinate with extremely aggressive establishment and very early spring green up

Beyond™

- Excellent density and aggressive traits crowd out Poa annua
- Scored top 10 varieties in University of Kentucky trial for Kentucky bluegrass shade tolerance

Navy™

- Medium dark color blends well with Jacklin elite blues
- Fast Establishment, early spring green-up, aggressive, Rust and Powdery Mildew resistant














Tall Fescue: Improved (cont.)

Quest™

Annual Ryegrass

Panterra™

- Unique non-persistent overseeding grass that makes for an easy spring transition
- Germinates at soil temps in the low 40's and is ideal for late-season over-seeding

Bridgeport II[™]

- Fine leaf Chewings fescue with a dark green color with strong shade tolerance in cooler climates

- Keeps color during the winter

Fine Fescue: Slender Creeping Red

Barpearl™

- Mixes well with other fine fescue species and is ideal in moderate, temperate climates
- Very quick green up in the spring and forms a very dense turf

Sprinkler™

- Good Dollar Spot and Red Thread resistance that mixes well with other fine fescue species
- Excellent for shaded areas and ideal in moderate, temperate climates

Blue Genes™: 3-Way Kentucky Bluegrass Blend

Blue Genes is a 3-way Kentucky bluegrass blend selected from elite Jacklin varieties. Developed for excellent turf quality over a broad range of environmental conditions, the varieties in Jacklin's Blue Genes mixture complement each other.

Heisman[™]: 85/15 Kentucky Bluegrass/Perennial Ryegrass

Jacklin's Heisman Mixture is the MVP of seed blends. This combination makes for the ideal turf and research has shown that our Heisman combination of bluegrass and ryegrass produces the optimum blend of tillers in the maturing turf.

Overseeder II[™]: 70/30 Kentucky Bluegrass/Perennial Ryegrass

Jacklin's Overseeder II Mixture is designed for the renovation of turf areas subjected to damage from diseases such as necrotic ringspot, summer patch, *Poa annua* infestation or heavy traffic.

Athletic Pro II[™]: 50/50 Kentucky Bluegrass/Perennial Ryegrass

Athletic Pro II is a Jacklin quality mixture of 50% new generation perennial ryegrasses (*Lolium perenne*) and 50% Kentucky bluegrasses (*Poa pratensis*). It is tailored to athletic fields, playgrounds, golf course roughs, or other high traffic areas that receive less-than optimal care.

NoNet™: Spreading Tall Fescue Blend

Make way for Jacklin's NoNet spreading tall fescue (*Festuca arundinacea*). NoNet was developed to insure that its spreading trait reaches the end user along with the improved turf characteristics you expect from a Jacklin variety.

A-Plus[™]: 90/10 Tall Fescue/Kentucky Bluegrass

A-Plus is a Jacklin quality mixture of new generation tall fescues (Festuca arundinacea) and Kentucky bluegrass (Poa pratensis). It provides all of the outstanding characteristics of our Triple-A 100% tall fescue blend with a "plus" of improved sod-forming characteristics and recuperative potential by adding Jacklin Kentucky bluegrass.

Triple A[™]: 3-Way Tall Fescue Blend


Triple A turf-type tall fescue blend performs well in a broad range of climates and conditions. The varieties used in Triple A have an attractive, dark green color and improved leaf texture, which makes this blend an excellent choice for a broad range of turf applications.

Med Gold[™]: 3-Way Perennial Ryegrass Blend

Jacklin's Med Gold perennial ryegrass blend combines Jacklin's best perennial ryegrass (Lolium perenne). The varieties selected for this blend show improved seedling vigor and exhibit overall tolerances of common diseases and pests in turf.

Top Flight[™]: Perennial Ryegrass Blend

Top Flight is a specially designed blend of perennial ryegrasses created solely for the warm-season overseed market. Top Flight creates a lush green turf that is excellent for golf courses, parks, sports fields, and home lawns.
