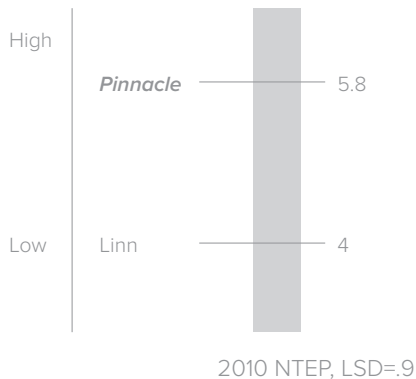

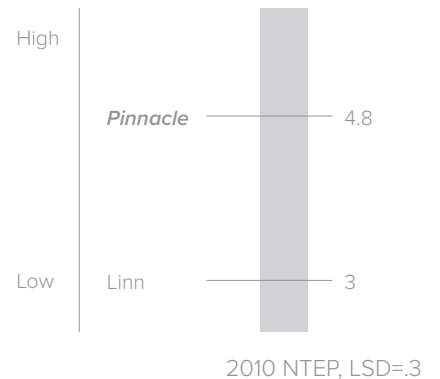
Applications

Pinnacle has a fine leaf texture, spring green up, and resistance to a variety of troublesome diseases. Pinnacle has found its niche in the market of perennial ryegrass overseed thanks to the aforementioned traits as well as its moderate density, enough to provide good turf cover, but not too dense to over-compete with bermudagrass or other warm season bases. Come late spring when bermudagrass wakes up, Pinnacle will naturally transition out unlike modern perennial ryegrasses that can really put up a fight, hindering bermuda stands year over year. Aside from use as a straight, you can find Pinnacle being utilized in the Top Flight blend.

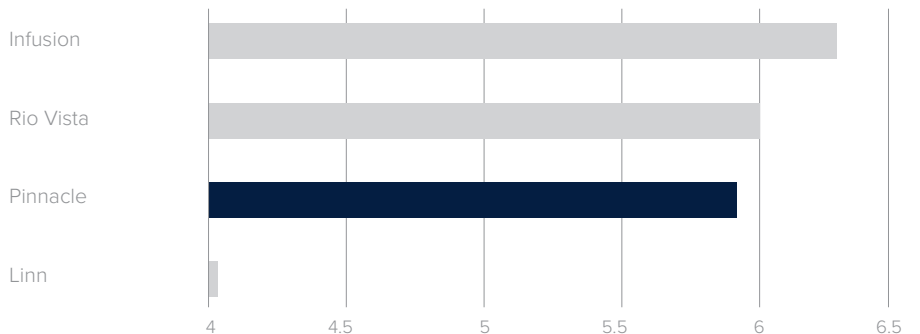
Leaf Texture
